Key Indicator - 4.2 Library as a Learning Resource

4.2.1 Library is automated using Integrated Library Management System (ILMS):

The central library of the College was established in the year 2007. It is housed in an area of 1199.5Sq.m. spread over two floors. The central library is fully automated with KOHA library automation software and a rich collection of books on all courses, references, national and international journals, e-journals, magazines etc., to quench the thirst of knowledge of the students as well as faculty members. This library follows open access system-Barcode based circulation process and WEB OPAC (Online Public Access Catalog) system which help to check the availability of the books.

The library has IEEE(ASPP) , DELNET, (IESTC) , ASTM E-Journals packages and 54 numbers of national journals, 54 numbers of international journals, 18 numbers of magazines and 8 numbers of daily newspapers,. At the end of every year, the journals are preserved as back volumes separately for future reference. The fourth floor of the library accommodates the course books totaling to 27267 volumes in 7968 titles, 1,141 CDs, 2,889 back volumes and 1940 Project Reports. Beyond the regular course books, 2,493 of general books covering the area of Motivation, General knowledge, Ethics, Autobiography of world leaders, Spiritualism etc., are available. Reference books pertaining to competitive examinations like GATE, TOFEL, TANCET etc., are maintained separately to assist the students who intend to prepare for the competitive examinations. Every year sufficient numbers of books are added to the library to cope up with the latest technological developments in the society

• Accessibility to students

- ❖ Each UG student, PG student can take 3 and 6 books respectively and retain for 15 days after which renewal is permitted for two times
- ❖ In the regular time table, one hour is allotted to utilize the library resources. Beyond the working hours the students are permitted to access the library resources
