Program Report

The Kongunadu College of Engineering and Technology, Internal Quality Assurance Cell organized a five days Short Term Course on **"Strategies for Effective Curriculum Implementation and Evaluation"** from 16.03.2026 to 20.03.2026 as a remote center with NITTTR, Chandigarh in online mode. 34 faculty members were benefited through this Faculty Development Program. The program was started with a welcome address delivered by Dr. PK Singla.

DAY 1 – 16/03/2026 (Monday)

Session-I: Dr. B. R. Gurjar, Dr. Rajesh Mehra and Dr. P. K. Singla jointly conducted the **"Inauguration and Introduction to the Course"**. The programme was formally inaugurated, and the session outlined the objectives, structure, and expected learning outcomes of the STC. Emphasis was placed on the importance of curriculum implementation and evaluation in strengthening academic quality.

Session-III: Dr. Sunil Dutt delivered a session on **“Student Evaluation: Significance, Aspects and Writing Test Items”**. The session focused on designing effective test items, evaluation techniques and ensuring fairness in student assessment.


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DAY 5 – 20/03/2026 (Friday)

Session-I: Dr. Jayanti Dutta delivered a session on **“Developing Thinking Skills Among the Students”**. The session emphasized critical thinking, problem-solving, and creativity as essential skills for learners.
